A3 Judges Assessment*

This assessment is aimed at B list judges who are following the traditional, Club route and **NOT** for those following the JEP route. **The traditional route expires on 31.12.2025**.

To apply for the A3 list you **MUST** have attained the following criteria:

- Judged 120 dogs
- Attended a BAD (formerly knows as breed specific educational seminar; either acceptable)
- Taken & passed multiple choice question paper on the breed standard
- Passed a Dobermann breed specific judging competence assessment*
- Attended & passed the KC RDSJ exam
- Attended the KC C&M seminar
- Attended & passed the KC PoD assessment
- Stewarded for a minimum of 12 full days
- Bred/owned minimum of 3 dogs when attaining their Stud Book number
- Have 7 years proven involvement in pedigree dogs

To transition to JEP Level 4 (CC approved) you must have applied & been passed onto the A3 list **PLUS** have then submitted **either** an A2 or Grandfathering application to the KC by **December 31**st **2025****. (** Unless you have been formally approved by the KC to award CC's in the future)

The spaces on this assessment are <u>very limited</u>; if you just require this assessment* to apply for the A3 list, we strongly recommend you book a place as we do not know if any further assessment opportunities will be available.
